Summary:

The Maintenance Technician performs general maintenance work, including mechanical, electrical, hydraulic, pneumatic, plumbing, layout and fabrication.

Roles / Responsibilities / Accountabilities:

Perform preventive and predictive maintenance on all assigned machinery, equipment, vehicles and facilities

Perform planned and emergency repairs on all assigned machinery, equipment, vehicles and facilities to minimize production lost time

Prioritize and schedule repair, maintenance, and installation of assigned machinery, equipment, vehicles and facilities to ensure continuous production operations

Install and adjust dairy processing and packaging machinery and equipment

Troubleshoot, analyze and implement corrective procedures in a safe and timely manner

Follow plant and department safety rules, administrative and documentation procedures

Organize, maintain and clean work areas to safeguard against safety issues and equipment loss

Direct the activities of outside contractors as required to maintain equipment and provide acceptance of work to ensure compliance to plant standards

Qualifications:

Requires a high school diploma and previous industrial maintenance experience with a strong aptitude in the areas of mechanical, electrical and structural maintenance

Knowledge of PLC's, automated controls, food processing and packaging equipment, boiler maintenance and refrigeration systems

Ability to quickly and effectively learn new equipment operation, troubleshooting and maintenance processes

Proficient in hydraulics, pneumatics, welding, HVAC, plumbing and pipe fitting, electrical and controls troubleshooting, layout and fabrication - includes heliarc for sanitary pipe welding and design and fabricating to meet 3A Standards

Must be self-motivated, have ability to manage multiple priorities in a fast paced environment, and be willing to contribute in a team environment.

Proficient operation of lift trucks, bobcat and other vehicles, along with a valid driver's license

Exceptional mechanical aptitude/experience performing general maintenance work

Demonstrated communication skills to interface well with co-workers, management and production employees

Required to support heavy manual lifting, work at heights, climb into and around machinery, and work in small spaces

Ability to prioritize, organize and schedule work, investigate work orders, and parts checkout
